- 6. Format: Books can come in a variety of formats, including hardcover, softcover, or electronic.
- 7. *Illustrations*: Many books include illustrations, such as photographs, drawings, or maps, to help explain or supplement the text.
- 8. Writing Style: The writing style of a book can vary greatly, from formal and academic to conversational and informal.

- 7. Reference: Book chapters often include references to other sources and literature to support the arguments and claims made within the chapter.
